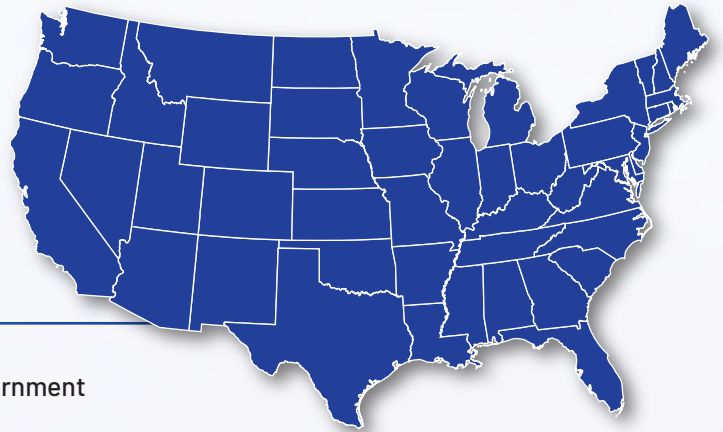

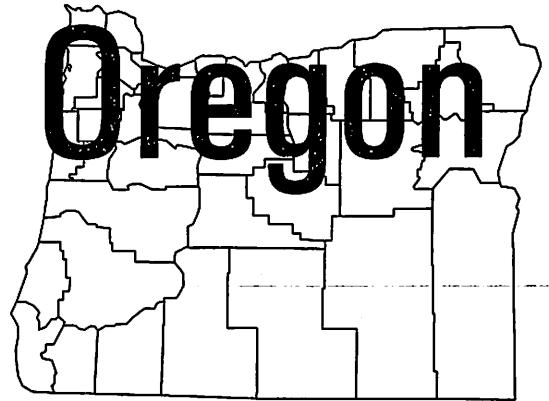

Criminal Records

The sites for firearms dealers - the Firearms Instant Check System - is found at www.oregon.gov/OSP/ID/pages/fics.aspx.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from 1920's. Records are retained indefinitely. These files can only be removed through expungment by court order or when a subject is reported as deceased and confirmed by fingerprints. New records available for inquiry in up to 8 days.

Searching: Three types of searches exist: open records search, own record search, and statutorily-required search. The latter can include an FBI fingerprint check for an additional \$16.50 fee. Include in request- (for open records) name, date of birth, last known address. Submitting the SSN is helpful, but not required. Fingerprints are required only when subject submits the request. For an open record request, if record exists, person of record will be notified of the request and the record will not be released for 14 additional days. Open record info includes all records with convictions and also all arrests within the past year without disposition. Statutorily-required record searches and own record searches include all records. Per a 2012 U.S. DOJ Study, 86% of all arrests in database have final dispositions

recorded, and 12% of all dispositions received cannot be matched to a specific arrest record.

Access by: mail, fax, online.

Fee & Payment: Open record search fee is \$10.00 per name. A search on oneself is \$33.00 and fingerprints are required. Statutorily-required searches are \$28.00 (\$27 if prints retained by this agency) plus FBI fingerprint fee, if required. \$5.00 fee to notarize. Fee payee: Oregon State Police. Prepayment required. Personal checks accepted. Credit/debit cards accepted online.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 7-10 business days. A Request Form is found at www.oregon.gov/OSP/ID/docs/crim_history.pdf.

Fax search: Requesters must be pre-approved, however records are not returned by fax.

Online search: A web based site is available for requesting and receiving criminal records is offered to registered users or to the public. Results are posted as "No Record" or "In Process" ("In Process" means a record will be mailed in 14 days). Use the "open records" link to get into the proper site. Fee is \$10.00 per record. See <http://xn.osp.state.or.us/openrec/>.

Sexual Offender Registry

ORS 181.592 authorizes the Oregon State Police to make information about registered sex offenders available to the public. Direct questions to sexoffender.questions@state.or.us.

Indexing & Storage: New records available for inquiry in up to 10 days.

Searching: As of May 2007 the Unit maintained files on 13,873 individuals who are required to register in Oregon. Include in request- name and DOB. The law allows the release of the names, DOB, photo, physical description, address or city of residence, supervising agency and phone number.

Access by: mail, phone, fax, online.

Fee & Payment: There is no fee for searches, but lists must be purchased. Fee payee: Oregon State Police, SOR Unit Prepayment required. Personal checks accepted.

Mail search: Turnaround time: up to 3 weeks.

Phone search: You can request a list or do a name check by phone. Also, you may leave you name, phone and search info, and the agency will call you back.

Fax search: Requests accepted via fax.

Online Visit <http://sexoffenders.oregon.gov/> for online searching of sex offenders who have been designated as Predatory. A mapping function is also offered. Be cautioned that the address and some of the information provided is information provided by the registrant and may not reflect the current residence, status, or other information regarding an offender. Two tribes in Oregon have searchable sex offender registries. The Warm Springs Tribe is at <http://warmsprings.nsopw.gov>. The Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation is at <http://ctuir.nsopw.gov>.

Other access: Lists by city or ZIP can usually be requested for no fee, a statewide list be purchased for \$85.00.

Indexing & Storage: Records available on current and former inmates. New records available for inquiry in up to 4 days.

Searching: The agency's complete policy on the release of records is found in a multi-page document at http://arcweb.sos.state.or.us/pages/rules/oars_200/oar_291/291_037.html. Include in request- full name; DOB and SID# helpful. Document request must be in writing. Location, SID number, physical identifiers, conviction and sentencing information, and release dates are provided. This data not released: medical data

Access by: mail, phone, fax, online.

Fee & Payment: Fees are charged for copies as follows: \$.50 for paper, \$1.25 from microfilm. Fee payee: Oregon DOC Prepayment required. Personal checks accepted.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 2 to 4 weeks. SASE not required.

Phone search: Name searching permitted by phone.

Fax search: Same criteria as mail.

Online search: An Offender Search is offered at <http://docpub.state.or.us/OOS/intro.jsf>. The site also lists contacts for each penitentiary or correction institution. The agency web page promotes a vendor offering free web access at <http://www.vinelink.com/vinelink/siteInfoAction.do?siteId=38000>; includes state, DOC, and most county jails. A Corrections Most Wanted list in the pull down menu box. Use imate.info@doc.state.or.us or mary.a.jenkins@doc.state.or.us to request by email.

Other access: Bulk sale of information is available. Contact ITS - Information Technology Services.

The Appellate Courts office is located at 1163 State St. The profile below indicates how to obtain records online. Otherwise, all requests must be done at the local circuit court.

Online search: Online access is via the OJCIN - Oregon Judicial Case Information Network. Oregon recently modified their online system while upgrading to a new platform. OECI is the new system (Odyssey) that the Circuit Courts are now converting into. This new system will eventually house the records statewide as Circuit Courts are converted. Both are fee-based systems. Only one log-in is required. The OJIN is now in 26 of the 36 counties. 10 counties have been converted to OECI Searching is either by single county or statewide. Indexing & Storage: Records available on the computer screen for 20 years after inactive. The business entity records prior to 20 years ago are stored in the State Archives back to the 1800's. New records available for inquiry immediately.

Searching: All information is public record. Include in request- full name of business and use the request form found at the web page. In addition to the articles of organization, business entity records available include: last annual report, Prior (merged) names, Articles of Amendment.

Access by: mail, phone, fax, in person, online.

Fee & Payment: There is no search fee. Copies cost \$5.00 per business name or \$15.00 if certified. A Certificate of existence is \$10.00. Fee payee: Corporation Division. Prepayment required. Personal checks accepted. Visa and MasterCard accepted.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 3 to 5 days. A SASE is requested.

Phone search: There is a limit of 3 searches per phone call. Data is only given verbally, records cannot be ordered.

Fax search: Requesters must use a credit card, turnaround time is 3 days or less.

In person search: Counter service is offered, but often the requester must return in 24 hours to pick up copies.

Online search: There is free access at http://egov.sos.state.or.us/br/pkg_web_name_srch_inq_login for business registry information. Search by name or business registry number. Displays active and inactive records. There are several other related searches available at <http://sos.oregon.gov/business/Pages/research-a-business.aspx> such as a search for consumer complaints on OR businesses.

Also, search a list of active trademarks at <http://sos.oregon.gov/business/Pages/trademarks.aspx>.

Other access: New business lists downloadable at <http://sos.oregon.gov/business/Pages/oregon-business-data-stats.aspx>.

State tax liens on personal property are filed here; state tax liens on real property are filed at the county level. A of March 2012 the Farm Products

Master List only includes farm product liens that have not lapsed, as required by ORS 80.118.

Indexing & Storage: Records available on microfiche to 1963. New records available for inquiry in 2 to 4 days.

Searching: Use search request form UCC-11. The search includes tax liens filed here. See www.filinginoregon.com/pages/forms/ucc/411.pdf Include in request- debtor name. This data not released: SSNs.

Access by: mail, fax, online.

Fee & Payment: The information request fee is \$10.00 per name, a request with copies is \$15.00 per name. A document number request is \$5.00. Add \$15.00 for a state seal certificate. Fee payee: Secretary of State. Prepayment required. Personal checks accepted. Visa and MasterCard accepted.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 1 to 4 days. A SASE is not needed, please do not send.

Fax search: A credit card is required. Results are mailed.

Online search: Form the home page search for information on UCC secured transactions, as well as Farm Product notices, IRS Tax Liens, Agricultural searches Liens, Agricultural Produce Liens, Grain Producer's Liens, Revenue Warrants and Employment Warrants. See <https://secure.sos.state.or.us/ucc/searchHome.action>. There are three search tabs to choose from. The Farm Products Registration and master List is available at <http://sos.oregon.gov/business/Pages/farm-products-master-list.aspx>. In general data is available one year after lapse of filing.

Other access: Filing lists for last month are at <http://sos.oregon.gov/business/Pages/ucc-data-lists.aspx>.

Sales Tax Registrations

Records not maintained by a state level agency. State does not impose sales tax.

Most county vital records offices in Oregon issue birth (and death) records for six months following the date of the event. Thus, another source to vital records offices is the county health department or county clerk's office.

Indexing & Storage: Records available for 07/1903 to present. There are some delayed filed, un-indexed records with DOBs from 1885 to 1904. Birth indexes prior to 1903 years available at the State Archives. New records available for inquiry in 2 to 4 weeks.

Searching: Investigative searches must have a signed, notarized release from person of record or immediate family member, unless record over 100 years old. Records only available to legal guardians & legal representatives with proof of such. Include in request- full name, names of parents, mother's full maiden name, date of birth, place of birth, relationship to person of record, reason for request. Must request "long form" if time of birth, hospital or physician's names is needed. This data not released: original birth

record prior to adoption unless adoptee requests and is over age of 21.

Access by: mail, phone, in person, online.

Fee & Payment: The search fee is \$20.00 by mail, \$23.25 for walk-in for first record then \$20.00 if other record are ordered as part of a group. Add \$15.00 for each additional copy. Fee payee: OHA Vital Records Prepayment required. Personal checks accepted for mail orders. Major credit cards accepted at counter and online.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 3 to 5 weeks. Express mail requests are handled immediately. SASE not required.

Phone search: See expedited service.

In person search: Self-service kiosks are available. There is a \$3.25 "authentication fee" to use the kiosk. The fee is per group of records ordered by someone, and not per record. Counter service wait is usually within 20 minutes, can be longer over noon period.

Online search: Order records online at www.vitalchek.com, the state's designated vendor. See Expedited Service.

Expedited service: Phone orders are billed to credit cards and processed the same or next day. There is an additional \$5.50 expedite fee and a \$8.95 service fee if ordered by phone or \$7.00 if by web. Plus cost of express delivery if desired. Turnaround time- 2 to 5 days.

Most county vital records offices in Oregon issue death (and birth) records for six months following the date of the event. Thus, another source to vital records offices is the county health department or county clerk's office.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from 1903 to present. Note that requests for non-certified copies are available from State Archives for reduced fee if record is more than 50 years old (503-373-0701). New records available for inquiry in 2 to 4 weeks.

Searching: Investigative searches must have a signed, notarized release from immediate family member or legal representative or person with a personal or property right. After 50 years, a record becomes public record and there are no restrictions. Include in request- full name, date of death, place of death, relationship to person of record, reason for information request. The name of the spouse is helpful. The date of birth is helpful for common names.

Access by: mail, phone, in person, online.

Fee & Payment: The search fee is \$20.00 by mail, \$23.25 for walk-in for first record then \$20.00 if other record are ordered as part of a group. Add \$15.00 for each additional copy. Fee payee: OHA Vital Records Prepayment required. Personal checks accepted for mail orders. Major credit cards accepted at counter and online.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 3 to 5 weeks. Express mail requests are processed immediately. SASE not required.

Phone search: See expedited service.

In person search: Self-service kiosks are available. There is a \$3.25 "authentication fee"

to use the kiosk. The fee is per group of records ordered by someone, and not per record. Counter service wait is usually within 20 minutes, can be longer over noon period.

Online search: Order records online at www.vitalchek.com, the state's designated vendor. See Expedited Service.

Other access: Indexes are available at many state libraries.

Expedited service: Phone orders are billed to credit cards and processed the same or next day. There is an additional \$5.50 expedite fee and a \$8.95 service fee if ordered by phone or \$7.00 if by web. Plus cost of express delivery if desired. Turnaround time- 2 to 5 days.

Marriage Certificates

Marriage licensing itself is done by the Counties, not the State. It is usually handled at the county clerks' office.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from 1910 to present. Early records are in an abbreviated form called "Return of Marriage." Records from 1906 to 1910 and 1946- to 1956 are in State Archives. New records available for inquiry in 4 to 8 weeks.

Searching: Records less than 50 years old are only available to family members, legal representatives or those with a personal or property right. Include in request- names of husband and wife, date of marriage, place or county of marriage, and reason for request. Include daytime phone number and as many identifiers as possible. This data not released: SSN, unless record order by registrant.

Access by: mail, phone, in person, online.

Fee & Payment: The search fee is \$20.00 by mail, \$23.25 for walk-in for first record then \$20.00 if other record are ordered as part of a group. Add \$15.00 for each additional copy. Fee payee: OHA Vital Records Prepayment required. Personal checks accepted for mail orders. Major credit cards accepted at counter and online.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 3 to 5 weeks. If request is expressed, it will be answered ASAP. SASE not required.

Phone search: See expedited service.

In person search: Self-service kiosks are available. There is a \$3.25 "authentication fee" to use the kiosk. The fee is per group of records ordered by someone, and not per record. Counter service wait is usually within 20 minutes, can be longer over noon period.

Online search: Order records online at www.vitalchek.com, the state's designated vendor. See Expedited Service.

Other access: Many state libraries offer record indexes.

Expedited service: Phone orders are billed to credit cards and processed the same or next day. There is an additional \$5.50 expedite fee and a \$8.95 service fee if ordered by phone or \$7.00 if by web. Plus cost of express delivery if desired. Turnaround time- 2 to 5 days.

Divorce Records

Standards for Federal Courts: District Courts indexed by defendant, plaintiff, and by case number. Bankruptcy Courts usually index by debtor and case number. Details on the Court Structure

Circuit Courts have original jurisdiction in all civil and criminal matters within the state, including probate, juvenile, and some traffic matters, as well as civil and criminal jury trials. The Small Claims limit is \$5,000. The Clerk of Court is the record custodian.

The majority of **Municipal Court** cases involve traffic and ordinance matters.

Probate filing is a function of the Circuit Court; however, each county has a **Register in Probate** who maintains and manages the probate, guardianship, and mental health records.

The **Oregon Tax Court** has exclusive jurisdiction to hear tax appeals including personal income tax, property tax, corporate excise tax, timber tax, local budget law and property tax limitations. There are 2 divisions: Magistrate Division and Regular Division.

Record Searching Facts You Need to Know

Fees and Record Searching Tips

Most Circuit Courts with computerized records have public access terminals using the OJIN system (see below). Most records offices close from Noon to 1PM Oregon time for lunch. No staff is available during that period.

Fees are set by Court Order (No. 13-064) and this fee schedule is followed by most courts. The copy fee is \$.25 per page, the certification fee is \$5.00 plus copy fees. The courts are permitted to charge \$2.00 for the first page and \$1.00 for ea add'l page for both incoming and outgoing faxes, but many courts choose not to fax.

Online Access is for All Circuit Courts

Online access is via the **OJCIN - Oregon Judicial Case Information Network**. Oregon recently modified their online system while upgrading to a new platform. OJCIN Online includes OJIN (Oregon Judicial Information Network), OECl (Oregon eCourt Case Information Network), and ACMS (Appellate Case Management System).

The OJIN **system** has been in place for years. OECl is the **new system** (Odyssey) that the Circuit Courts are now converting into. This new system will eventually house the records statewide as Circuit Courts are converted. Both systems fee-based systems. Only one log-in is required. The access point will allow (force) the user to choose which system to access. For more information see <http://courts.oregon.gov/OJD/OnlineServices/OJIN/Pages/index.aspx>.

About OJIN:

The OJIN is now in 26 of the 36 counties in the state. Ten counties have been converted to OECl (see below). OJIN allows one to search for civil, small claims, tax, domestic, and criminal cases. The search mechanism allows single county or statewide searching for either civil or criminal cases. Note OJIN does not provide records from Municipal or County Courts. Also Circuit cases that are confidential and protected statutorily are not available to the public.

About OECl:

All courts/counties will have migrated to OECl by sometime in 2016. At the time this book was printed, the ten counties currently on this system are Benton, Clatsop, Columbia, Crook, Jackson,

Jefferson, Linn, Multnomah, Polk, Tillamook, and Yamhill.

The Fees for Subscribers

The fees for access to OJIN changed rather drastically on April 1, 2014. Prior to the date there was a one-time setup fee of \$295.00 plus a monthly usage fee per user based on the type of search, if printed, and time of day, plus the minimum monthly usage is \$10.00.

For subscribers whose account was initiated before January 1, 2014, the monthly charge is the average monthly bill in 2013. For subscribers whose account was initiated after January 1, 2014 but before July 1, 2014, the monthly charge is the average monthly bill in 2014. For subscribers signing up after July 1, 2014, there is a \$100.00 one time fee to establish the account and a fee of \$35.00 per month per user, plus the same criteria to figure the monthly fee. Comments on Equivalency

The information from both systems is provided in real time from the Oregon Judicial Department database. The online system displays the same data as displayed on public access terminals at the courts. The onsite terminals use OJIN or OECL. To do a true statewide search, both systems must be used.

Feedback

There has been some pushback regarding the new system, More time is needed to perform a search. The initial docket data displayed on OECL does not provide as many details as OJIN. Additional screens often must be viewed to see docket status or final disposition. There are also inconsistent data elements. However, reportedly there is a committee of attorneys working with Odyssey to overcome these problems. The ultimate purpose is to create a more modern, user-friendly environment for record access, compared to the OJIN command line based system.

Oregon Recording Offices

- Organization:** 36 counties, 36 recording offices. The recording officer is the County Clerk. 35 Oregon counties are in the Pacific Time Zone (PST); the exception is Malheur County in the Mountain Time Zone (MST).
- Types of Documents Recorded:** Documents include property records such as deeds, mortgages, liens, easements and subdivision plats among other records. Other categories the Clerk manages include Marriage Licenses, Domestic Partnerships, Dog Licenses, Voter Registration and Elections.
- Searching Real Estate Records:** Some counties will not perform real estate searches and where they do, search fee vary widely. Often a \$3.75 Location fee is applied. Copy fee is usually \$.25 per page, a mailing fee is often added if mailed. Certification fee is \$3.75 per document. Note the Assessor keeps tax and ownership records.
- Searching UCC Records:** Financing statements are filed at the state level except for real estate related collateral. A few county clerks will perform UCC searches; fees vary from \$3.50 to \$13.50. We suggest to call first.
- Searching Tax Lien Records:** All federal and state tax liens on personal property are filed with the Secretary of State. Other federal and state tax liens are filed with the County Clerk. Government agencies file 'warrants' that represent liens for unpaid taxes and other state fees. Certain warrants are filed with the Sec. of State such as those related to income tax and hazardous waste and are included in a UCC search. Other warrants are filed at the county level, such as those relating to employment taxes. A few counties will perform tax lien searches and include them with a UCC search.
- Online Access:** Only 12 counties offer access to recorded documents. There is no statewide system.

Quite a few counties offer Web access to assessor records. The ORMAP Tax Viewing System at <http://www.ormap.net/> provides GIS maps free for all counties. Search by county, then by address. While there is no name searching and maps are pdfs arranged in folders (and you may zoom into a map location), this is a step toward owner identification.
