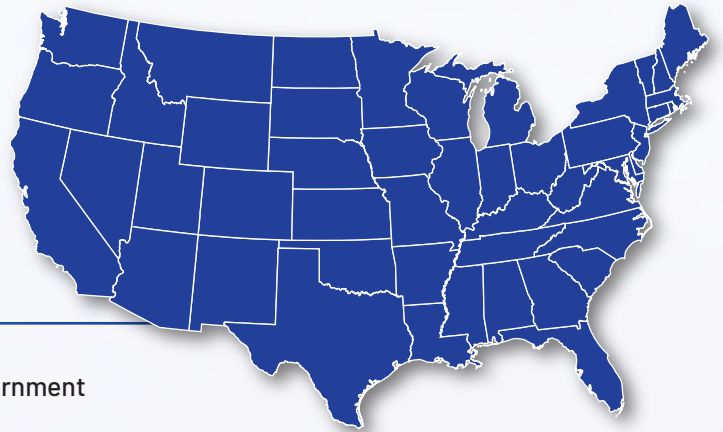

SPRLs are an ideal tool for returning citizens looking to identify sources and repositories of public record documents and those seeking to conduct legal research.

State Public Record Listings Includes 28,000+ Agencies:

- **Agency Facts:** office hour; time zone; web sites, types of records held.
- **Search and Access Facts:** all methods of access; indexing; search requirements; how far back records are kept and available, online availability with comments on accuracy; when public access terminals are onsite; turnaround times.

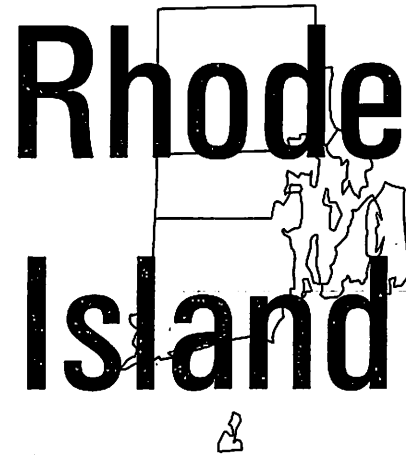

Indexing & Storage: Records available from 1900's. New records available for inquiry in 1-7 days.

Searching: Criminal records are only released to law enforcement agencies, the subject, or to those with a signed notarized authorization from the subject. Include in request- signed notarized release from subject; the requester must provide copy of photo from DL, state-issued ID or passport. Fingerprints and are optional. They will call the Notary on the authorization for verification. 100% of the records are fingerprint-supported. A form for third party use is found at www.riag.ri.gov/documents/bci/bcidisclaimer.pdf. All arrests and convictions are reported. 75% of all arrests in database have final dispositions recorded.

Access by: mail, in person, .

Fee & Payment: The fee is \$5.00 for a name search. If required, the a fingerprint search without an FBI search is \$15, with the FBI fingerprint search is \$35.00. Fee payee: Department of Attorney General. Prepayment required. Personal checks or money orders accepted. No credit cards or cash accepted.

Mail search: Turnaround time: up to 2 weeks. A SASE is required.

In person search: Turnaround time is while you wait.

Other access: This agency does not offer online access, but the state court system does offer an information site but is not considered an official search. See that profile for details.

No agency, including any Law Enforcement Agency or any state agency, may direct where the offender does or does not reside, nor can these agencies direct where the offender works or goes to school.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from 07-24-96 (online).

Access by: mail, online.

Mail search: SASE is requested. The agency will merely respond by sending the web page listing.

Online search: Website information about a sex offender is available to the public only if the Sex Offender Board of Review has classified the offender as a Level 3, or as a Level 2 as of January 1, 2006. Per Rhode Island Law information pertaining to Level 1 sex offenders cannot be

posted on the website. Go to www.paroleboard.ri.gov/sexoffender/agree.php. Also, search by town or ZIP.

Indexing & Storage: Records available on current and former inmates. New records available for inquiry in 1 to 3 days.

Searching: Include in request- full name; DOB helpful. Location, physical identifiers, conviction and sentencing information, and release dates are provided.

Access by: mail, phone, fax, online.

Fee & Payment: There is no search fee.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 30 days. SASE not required.

Phone search: Limited name searching available by phone.

Fax search: Records are available by fax.

Online search: A free DOC search is available at www.doc.ri.gov/inmate_search/index.php. The database only has inmates currently incarcerated and there is a 24 hour lag time on updates.

Indexing & Storage: New records available for inquiry in 24 hours.

Searching: Include in request- names involved or case number.

Access by: mail, in person, online.

Mail search: Requests are accepted by mail. A SASE is required.

In person search: Limited in-person searching of Supreme, District, Superior, and Family court cases are available. Most records available are from the mid 1980's to the present.

Online search: The Rhode Island Judiciary offers free access to court criminal records statewide at <http://courtconnect.courts.state.ri.us>. The year of birth is shown on results. A couple of cautions. The online site is known to show cases that were sealed or were supposed to be removed. Access to civil records is not available (regardless of what drop down box says). Also the site's disclaimer states this data is provided as an informational service only and should not be relied upon as an official record of the court. There is no statewide access to other types of court records, including civil, family or probate. Supreme Court and Appellate opinions are available from www.courts.state.ri.us/supreme/defaultnew-supreme.htm.

Other access: Bulk data is available, call for details.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from the beginning of the Division. Records are computerized since 1984, archives to 1776. New records available for inquiry in 1-2 business days.

Searching: Include in request- full name of business.

Access by: mail, phone, in person, online.

Fee & Payment: The copy fee is \$.15 per page. Certification costs \$10.00 per document plus copy fees, \$5.00 if a non-profit. A Good Standing is \$20.00, \$5.00 if for non-profit. There is no search fee. Fee payee: Secretary of State. Personal checks accepted. Credit cards only accepted if online.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 7 to 10 days. A SASE helpful.

Phone search: They will give date of incorporation, registered agent, one officer, status, and whether domestic or foreign. Certified copies and documents can be ordered by phone, but must be picked up in person, takes 48 hours.

In person search: Certified copies may not be available same day. Most Good Standing documents are issued upon request.

Online search: At the web, search filings for active and inactive Rhode Island and foreign business corporations, corporations, limited liability partnerships, limited liability companies, limited liability partnerships, and the non-profits as well. Weekly listings of new corporations are also available. There is no fee. A variety of certifications can also be requested, fees involved. Online filing is available for corporations, LLCs and LPs.

Other access: Various databases may be downloaded or purchased on CD. Call for pricing.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from the beginning of the Division. A mark is registered for 10 years. New records available for inquiry in less than one week.

Searching: All records are open to the public. Include in request- trademark/service mark name, registration number and applicant name, if known.

Access by: mail, phone, in person, online.

Fee & Payment: A search fee may apply depending on how extensive. The copy fee is \$.15 per page. Fee payee: Secretary of State Personal checks accepted.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 3 to 5 days. SASE not required.

Phone search: Limited verification information available.

In person search: Counter service is available.

Online search: Search trademark/service marks at <http://ucc.state.ri.us/trademarks/trademarksearch.asp>.

Other access: For a fee of \$100 per year, the agency will provide quarterly disks with all new filings processed in a quarter. Set dates are Jan 1, April 1, July 1, and Oct 1.

Indexing & Storage: New records available for inquiry in 24 hours.

Searching: Use search request form UCC-11. All tax liens are filed at the city/town level. Include in request- debtor name. Office does not index personal data other than name and address.

Access by: mail, in person, online.

Fee & Payment: The search fee is \$5.00 per name, copies are \$.15 each. Add \$5.00 for certification. Fee payee: Secretary of State. Prepayment required. Personal checks accepted. Credit cards accepted only online.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 1 to 2 working days. SASE recommended.

In person search: Visitors may use the public access terminal to view records. This is the same system used for online viewing.

Online search: View debtor names at <http://sos.ri.gov/business/ucc/database/>. One may also search by file number or business organization. Rhode Island's UCC Public Search Index allows its users to search using both Standard Search Logic and Non-Standard Search Logic.

Other access: Bulk data can be purchased by request. Call for details.

Records not maintained by a state level agency. All tax lien records are filed at the local level.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from the 1960's. All current permits are on the computer, all inactive records are kept on microfiche. New records available for inquiry immediately.

Searching: This agency will only confirm that a business is registered. They will provide no other information. Include in request- business name or tax permit number.

Access by: mail, phone, fax, online.

Fee & Payment: There is no search fee nor a copy fee, unless extensive documents are requested.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 7 to 10 days. A SASE is requested.

Phone search: It will take 24 hours for a response.

Fax search: Same criteria as mail searching.

Online search: View administrative decisions at www.tax.state.ri.us/AdministrativeDecisions/. Search by Tax Type or Decision Number.

Expedited service: Will try to expedite search, if requested.

City and town clerk offices have records for most births, deaths, and marriages that occur in those cities and towns. If the birth occurred after 12/31/1959, it can be obtained from any the city or town in RI.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from 100 years to present. Older records are transferred to the RI State Archives, 401-222-2353. New records available for inquiry in 1 week.

Searching: Birth records are public once over 100 years old. Include in request- full name, names of parents, mother's maiden name, date of birth, place of birth. Requester must provide the relationship to the person of record and valid, gov't issued photo. Requester must provide the relationship to the person of record and valid, gov't issued photo ID.

Access by: mail, in person, .

Fee & Payment: The fee is \$20.00 per record (add'l copies of same record issued \$15.00 each), if uncertain of the date the search covers a 2-year searching period. There is a \$2.00 search fee for

each additional year searched. Fee payee: General Treasurer, State of Rhode Island. Prepayment required. Personal checks and money orders accepted.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 6 to 8 weeks. For 1 business week service, add an additional \$7.00 and mark "rush" on outside of envelope. A SASE is not requested. Include photo copy of requester's valid government issued ID.

In person search: Simple requests may be processed while you wait.

Expedited service: Turnaround time- 5 days. Add \$7.00 for processing.

Records less than 50 years old can also be obtained at the town or city where death took place.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from 50 years to present. Older records are transferred to the RI State Archives, 40-,222-2353. New records available for inquiry in within one month.

Searching: Include in request- full name, date of death, place of death, names of parents, mother's maiden name. Requester should provide reason for requester, relationship to the subject, and government issued photo ID.

Access by: mail, in person, .

Fee & Payment: The fee is \$20.00 per record, if uncertain of the date the search covers a 2-year searching period. There is a \$2.00 search fee for each additional year searched. Fee payee: General Treasurer, State of Rhode Island. Prepayment required. Personal checks and money orders accepted.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 6 to 8 weeks. For one-week service, add an additional \$7.00 and mark "rush" on outside of envelope. A SASE is not requested. Include photo copy of requester's ID (DL, passport, etc).

In person search: Simple requests may be processed while you wait.

Expedited service: Turnaround time- 5 days. Add \$7.00 for processing.

The record may be also obtained from the town or city where the marriage took place, if the record is less than 100 years old.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from 100 years to present, older records sent to State Archives. New records available for inquiry immediately.

Searching: Requester must be person of record or immediate family members. Include in request- names of husband and wife, date of marriage, place or county of marriage, wife's maiden name. Requester should also provide reason for the request, relationship to subject, and copy of government issued photo ID.

Access by: mail, in person, .

Fee & Payment: The fee is \$20.00 per record, if uncertain of the date the search covers a 2-year searching period. There is a \$2.00 search fee for each additional year searched. Fee payee: General Treasurer, State of Rhode Island. Prepayment required. Personal checks accepted.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 6 to 8 weeks. For one-week service, add an additional \$7.00 and mark "rush" on outside of envelope. A SASE is not requested. Include photo copy of requester's ID (DL, passport, etc).

In person search: Simple requests may be processed while you wait.

Expedited service: Turnaround time- 5 days. Add \$7.00 for processing.

Divorce Records

Records not maintained by a state level agency. Divorce records are found at one of the 5 county Family Courts.

Indexing & Storage: Records available from 1980s. New records available for inquiry immediately.

Searching: Records are not available for employment screening. A first report of injury is not public, by law. Records are released to claimant, attorneys, employer and insurer only if connected to case. Include in request- claimant name, Social Security Number, file number (if known), reason for information request, specific records that you need copies of. Records of insurance carrier coverage only are available for no charge by phone or mail. This data not released: medical records.

Access by: mail, fax, in person, .

Fee & Payment: The search fee is \$15.00 per hour. Copies are \$.15 per page. There is a \$.40 per page fee for return by fax. Fee payee: Department of Labor & Training. Prepayment required for first time. Personal checks accepted. No credit cards accepted.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 1 to 2 weeks. A SASE is requested.

Fax search: You may request records by fax.

In person search: Proof of identity is required.

Other access: Workers' Compensation Court calendars are available free at www.courts.ri.gov/CourtCalendars/Pages/Workers%27%20Compensation%20Court.aspx.

The agency follows DPPA. Ongoing requesters should be approved and have an account. Casual

requesters must have consent of subject or no record is given.

Indexing & Storage: Records available for 3 years for accidents and moving violations, 5 years for alcohol-related violations or suspensions, 3 years after reinstatement for suspensions. Surrendered licenses are purged 3 years after expiration. New records available for inquiry in 20 days after received from courts.

Searching: Information is not made available for the purpose of commercial solicitation or trade. A description of proposed use must be submitted in advance for departmental approval of high volume requesters. Include in request- driver's license number, full name, date of birth. Use of a state form suggested but not required; find the form at www.dmv.state.ri.us/documents/forms/Reg-DL_App.pdf. Copies of tickets may be obtained without fee by writing to the Traffic Tribunal at 670 New London Ave, Cranston RI 02920. This data not released: SSNs.

Access by: mail, in person, online.

Fee & Payment: The fee is \$17.50 per record request, \$19.50 if online. Fee payee: Division of Motor Vehicles. Prepayment required. Personal checks accepted. No credit cards accepted.

Mail search: Turnaround time: 7-10 days. A SASE is requested.

In person search: Most requests can be handled immediately.

Online search: Driving records are available in two manners. From the home page above, anyone may request a record online, pay the \$19.50 service fee with a credit card and the record will be mailed to the address shown on the DL. This record does not contain the driver's address or SSN. The driver name, DOB and license number must be submitted. Ongoing requesters who qualify to receive records with personal information may obtain a subscription account for interactive service. The same record fee applies. Indexing & Storage: Records available for 3 years for title information, for 10 years for registration information. New records available for inquiry in 1 week.

Searching: Request must be in writing and the purpose stated. Records will not be released for commercial or solicitation purposes. Casual requesters cannot obtain records unless written consent of subject is given. Include in request- for title: reason for request, VIN, year, make, owner name/address, your signature. Details on the Court Structure

The **Superior Court** has original jurisdiction in all felony proceedings, in civil cases where the amount in controversy exceeds \$10,000, and in equity matters. The court has concurrent jurisdiction with the District Court in civil matters when the amount in controversy is between \$5,000 and \$10,000.

The **District Court** has exclusive jurisdiction of all civil actions at law wherein the amount in controversy is under \$5,000. The District Court handles arraignments for felony and misdemeanor cases. Misdemeanor cases are punishable for up to one year in prison and fines are not to exceed \$1,000. There are no jury trials heard in District Court.

Rhode Island has five counties but only four **Superior/District Court Locations**— 2nd-Newport, 3rd-Kent, 4th-Washington, and 6th-Providence/Bristol Districts. **Bristol and Providence counties are completely merged at the Providence location.** For questions regarding the Superior Courts, telephone 401-222-2622. 26 of the 39 cities and towns in Rhode Island have **Municipal Courts**. In general, Municipal Courts oversee traffic, ordinance, housing and zoning violations, but not every court has authority in all areas. The Municipal Courts do not hear cases involving state criminal laws nor are they administrated by the State Court Administrator's Office. Probate is handled by the Town Clerk at the 39 cities and towns, not at the Superior or District courts. The contact information is shown herein.

Civil traffic violations will be heard either at a Municipal Court or at the **Traffic Tribunal** which has original jurisdiction over civil traffic offenses committed in Rhode Island, including breathalyzer refusals. Reach the Traffic Tribunal at 401-275-2700.

Record Searching Facts You Need to Know

Fees and Record Searching Tips

The copy fee has been set at \$.15 per page; one District Court refuses to make copies – you must do yourself. Most courts will not perform a name search. All courts permit the public to do its own in-person searching of Supreme, District, Superior, and Family Court cases. Throughput dates of the records indices vary. Note that requests for court files from the Court Administrator are not governed by the Access to Public Records Act.

Online Access for Criminal, But Use Caution

The Rhode Island Judiciary provides two online record search systems; however, one system is not open to everyone.

1. CourtConnect

The general public has free access to an index of county criminal cases statewide at <http://courtconnect.courts.state.ri.us>. Access to civil records is not available (regardless of what drop down box says).

There are several consideration to keep in mind regarding the use of this system:

- Only the year of birth is shown on results.
- There is a very strong disclaimer that specifically states this site cannot be used for background checks or employment screening.
- Comments from local record searchers indicate this site is known to show cases that were sealed or were supposed to be removed. It is suggested to confirm case existence before reporting to a client.

2. Public Access Portal

Since 11/5/2014, the Judiciary's Public Access Portal (www.courts.ri.gov/access-caseinfo/default.aspx) provides access to a database of court records displayed as a register of actions or docket sheet. This system provides access to Civil, Family Court, and Workers' Compensation Court, but not to criminal case records. **Despite the name, this system is only open to attorneys, self-represented litigants and to state or federal agencies, but NOT to the public.** Registration and a subscription agreement are both required. This system can be accessed via the Web or from terminals located onsite at the courthouses. However, there are several limitations

1. For all other cases in which they are not directly involved, attorneys shall have remote access to the register of actions or docket but shall not have remote access to other electronic case information
2. Self-represented litigants shall have no greater access than the public to information about cases in which they are not directly involved.

There are an additional 40,000 place names that people use in their addresses. Therefore, we have also included a ZIP/City Cross Reference immediately following the City/County Cross Reference.

If you know the ZIP Code but the city name does not appear in the City/County Cross Reference index, look up the ZIP Code in the ZIP/City Cross Reference, find the city name, then look up the city name in the City/County Cross Reference. For example, you want to know the county for an address of Menands, NY 12204. There is no "Menands" in the City/County Cross Reference. The ZIP/City Cross Reference shows that ZIP Codes 12201-12288 are for the city of Albany. Looking back in the City/County Cross Reference, Albany is in Albany County.
